## **HOT HEATS**

Cash prizes for the winner of randomly selected Heats

Any Age Group. Any Stroke. Any Distance. Any Heat could be a **HOT HEAT**:

Age: as at Round 1 of the Series

**Age Groups:** 9/under, 10 - 11, 12 - 13, 14 - 15, 16/over

Entries: \$12.00 per Event; \$7.00 per Event for Beginner Events. Entry via Swim Central or TM file emailed to

the Meet Director. No late entries will be accepted. Refunds will only be granted if the Entry is rejected

by the Meet Director.

Each swimmer will be allowed to enter a maximum of four (4) swims in each Round.







## **Conditions:**

All Events are mixed Age, Gender and Category. Categories are **Age Group** and **Multi-class**. Swimmers must compete in their own Age Group category **or** in the Multi-class category for the entire Series. A change of category during the Series is not permitted. Swimmers must declare their intention to compete as a multi-class swimmer and email their MC credentials to the Meet Director prior to their first Meet. Although not competing in an Age Group category, the Events a multi-class swimmer can enter will still be determined by their age.

Swimmers may compete in the same Stroke/Distance event in more than one Round of the Series but only their fastest swim will be used to determine any points that may be earned. Be aware that by swimming the same Stroke/Distance event more than once, swimmers will lessen their opportunity to score the maximum points possible. 25m events are open to Beginners of any age. A Beginner is one who has never successfully completed the stroke over a distance greater than 25m. 25m events will not earn points.

## Awards:

During the course of the Series, the top three swimmers in each Category and Gender for each Event will receive a ribbon. Ribbons will not be awarded for "Choice" Events. Overall awards winners will be determined following the completion of Round 4. A swimmer must compete in three of the four Rounds to be eligible for an award.

**For the Age Group categories**, the times from all events contested across the Series will be consolidated into a single report to determine the best three swimmers of the Series in each Age Group and Gender. Age Group category aggregate points will be allocated thus, based on times: Fastest – 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> fastest – 4 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> fastest – 3 points, 4<sup>th</sup> fastest – 2 points, 5<sup>th</sup> fastest – 1 point. For each Age Group and Gender, the three highest aggregate points-earners will be awarded a trophy.

**For the Multi-class category**, points will be scored using the Swimming Australia Multi-class Points Score (MCPS) calculator. Points from all events contested across the Series will be consolidated into a single report to determine the best three swimmers of the Series in each Gender. Multi-class category aggregate points will be allocated thus, based on the MCPS calculator: Highest points – 6 points, 2<sup>nd</sup> highest – 4 points, 3<sup>rd</sup> highest – 3 points, 4<sup>th</sup> highest – 2 points, 5<sup>th</sup> highest – 1 point.

For each Gender, the three highest aggregate points-earners will be awarded a trophy.

The **Mark Poustie Trophy** and a \$100 scholarship will be awarded to the 12/under swimmer who earns the highest number of aggregate points in 50m and/or 100m events.

The **Stables/Evely Trophy** will be awarded to the Club that earns the highest number of aggregate points.

**Meet Program:**The Meet Program will be available for download from Swim Central and will be published on Meet Mobile by the Thursday prior to each Round.

**Results:** At the Meet, results will be published on Meet Mobile only.
